
### DEQ Rebate Program Updates: OCVRP & ZERO Fleet



### **OCVRP** Refresher

- Rebates awarded since 2018
- Two types of rebates offered:
  - Standard rebates:
    - \$750 \$2,500 rebate
    - Available to all Oregonians
    - New vehicles only
    - Available at POS or post-purchase
  - Charge Ahead rebates:
    - \$5,000 \$7,500 rebate
    - Income-eligible rebate
    - New and used vehicles
    - Available post-purchase, or POS with a prequalification voucher
- Funding: Vehicle Privilege Tax (and federal funding in 2025)













### **Eligibility Comparison**

# Standard Rebate

**Who:** Oregon residents, businesses, nonprofits & government agencies

**No** income requirement

Only eligible, **NEW** battery electric vehicles, plug-in hybrids, and ZEMs

On the program's eligible vehicle list

Purchase or lease through a certified **vehicle dealership** 

**Register vehicle** in Oregon and retain registration for at least 24 months

Rebate applications submitted within **6 months** after purchase or lease date

Available at **point of sale** at a "Participating Dealership" or **post- purchase or lease** 

# Charge Ahead Rebate

**Who:** Income-eligible Oregon residents and low-income service providers

Household income of **less than 400%** of federal poverty guidelines


Point of sale requires a **Charge Ahead Prequalification Voucher** 

**NEW** and **USED** eligible battery electric and plug-in hybrid vehicles



### 2025 Program Reopening Updates

- As of December 13, 2025, DEQ has approved:
  - Over 33,000 rebates
  - Over \$99 M over the lifetime of the program
  - In 2024 (April 3 June 3):
    - 3,540 rebates
    - About \$14.5 M
- 2025 Open Period:
  - Spring 2025
  - All vehicles must be obtained while program is open to be eligible

#### Steps to Participate



#### **Enroll your Dealership**

Ensure you meet all dealership eligibility requirements.



#### Create an Account

ACH information must be provided before the dealership can begin submitting applications.



#### **Submit Rebate Applications**

Applicants and vehicles must be eligible. You must submit all required documentation on behalf of the Applicant.



#### Dealership Eligibility


To enroll as a Participating Dealership, you must meet the following requirements.

- · Licensed to sell vehicles in Oregon
- · Have a valid tax identification number
- · Sell a rebate-eligible electric vehicle

#### How to Enroll your Dealership

Dealerships that meet the criteria outlined above are eligible to enroll in the Program. The enrollment process is simple—click the button below labeled "Enroll Dealership" and complete a short form to get started.

Please note: The individual that fills out the enrollment form will be considered the primary contact for the dealership and will be responsible for managing the dealership account. Typically, the primary contact is either the dealership owner, general manager, finance manager or a person in a similar position with access to the dealership's banking information.





### Zero Emissions Rebates for Oregon Fleets (ZERO Fleet)

- The ZERO Fleet program accelerates the adoption of zero-emission vehicles through rebates designed for medium and heavy-duty vehicles:
  - Total Funding amount: \$17 Million
  - Rebates range from \$2,500 to \$120,000, depending on vehicle weight class.
  - Prioritizes funding for frontline communities disproportionately affected by diesel pollution.
  - Targets a t least 40% of rebates for projects improving air quality in vulnerable areas.
